### **September**

- ◇ Check current course selections to ensure they meet admission requirements for graduation and post-secondary programs.
- ◇ Applications due for SK Polytechnic First Qualified/First Admitted programs. This is for all programs except the high demand and nursing programs.
- ◇ Check application dates for out of province post-secondary schools
- ◇ Apply for a Social Insurance Number (SIN)
- ◇ Register for open house tours
- ◇ Explore residence options at post-secondary locations
- ◇ Explore scholarship opportunities
- ◇ U of S (Saskatoon) Open house - September 28
- ◇ U of C (Calgary) - September 29



### **October**

- ◇ U of S, U of R applications open
- ◇ High demand programs at SK Polytechnic open (Dental Hygiene, Medical Radiologic Tech, Power Engineering Tech, Practical Nursing)
- ◇ Nursing applications open for Collaborative Nursing program at SK Polytechnic
- ◇ Olds College Open house—October 12
- ◇ NAIT (Edmonton) Open house - October 12 & 13
- ◇ SUTIL career fair (JPIL)—October 16
- ◇ Try-A-Trade at North Battleford Fieldhouse —October 17
- ◇ SK Polytechnic Information Night - October 18
- ◇ SAIT (Calgary), Lakeland College (Vermillion & Lloyd) Open house - October 19 & 20
- ◇ U of R, U of A (Edmonton) and U of L (Lethbridge) Open house - October 20
- ◇ ACAD (Alberta College of Art & Design) tours - monthly



## November



- ◇ U of S residence applications open
- ◇ See Your Future Career Fair - November 5(Saskatoon) & November 6 (Regina)

## December

- ◇ December 1 - U of S - early conditional admission for certain colleges
- ◇ December 15 - U of S - application deadline for those wanting to be considered for the Best and Brightest scholarships

## January

- ◇ Prepare for semester I final exams
- ◇ Continue to explore scholarship opportunities - soon new applications will be available more frequently
- ◇ Check deadlines for out of province post-secondary schools



## February

- ◇ February 15 - U of S - Business, Engineering, Agriculture, Education, Arts & Science Bachelor of Music and Bachelor of Music Education & Kinesiology applications deadline
- ◇ February 15 - Collaborative Nursing program (U of R) at SK Polytechnic - application due
- ◇ February 15 - SK Polytechnic - high demand program applications due

## March

- ◇ March 15 - U of R - priority application deadline for most programs - priority deadline is the recommended deadline to ensure best course selection and to take advantage of other university services such as applying for residence or applying for scholarships and awards.
- ◇ U of R - scholarship applications due

## April

- ◇ Set up an appointment with a post-secondary academic counsellor if you need assistance with course selections for your program of study.

## May

- ◇ May 1—U of S—application deadline for NORTEP, SUNTEP, ITEP, ACTEP
- ◇ U of R -UR Beginning (new students for Fall)
- ◇ U of S - U-start registration workshop at NWRC

**Registration day for your fall classes is approaching. If needed, be sure you attend your institution's registration workshop.**



**JOHN PAUL II COLLEGIATE****June**

- ◇ June 1 - U of R - residence applications due
- ◇ Canada student loan applications become available.
- ◇ Registration for university classes.
- ◇ Make sure that your official transcript request has been completed to ensure that your post-secondary institution of choice will receive a final copy of your high school marks.
- ◇ If you completed Advanced Placement courses, send your test scores to the post-secondary school so you can receive credit for those courses.

**Important Information**

**Final Reminders**

- ◇ Be sure to log in to your post-secondary account for any updates, payments or important information regarding your studies in the fall.

- ◇ Many scholarship's due dates are in the summer and fall. Be sure you don't miss out on any of these opportunities.
